WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT THE PROPOSED PLAN

CFAC wrote the proposed cleanup plan for the EPA.

CFAC and Atlantic Richfield Company (ARCO) are responsible for cleanup costs. CFAC said removing the waste was likely a permanent and effective solution, but that it was "too costly."

CFAC's parent company reported \$250 Billion in revenue in 2022.



About 40 toxic chemicals, including cyanide, fluoride, arsenic, and selenium, are buried on site putting the Flathead River at risk forever.



CFAC's proposed plan to build a slurry wall is "technically impracticable" according to experts and makes the site off-limits to most human uses.



From 1990 – 2009, CFAC regularly removed toxic waste safely by rail to a certified hazardous waste landfill.
